

April 2027 Admission Guidelines for application to doctoral program In The Cooperative Major in Medical Photonics

Items to be added/included under "Application Documents" or "Application Procedures"

- Please ensure that all information provided in your application and all submitted documents are accurate and factual. If any false statements, falsifications, or misconduct are discovered, the university may take measures such as revoking your passing status or admission, even after your application has been accepted or the entrance examination has been administered.

Items to be added/included under "Examination Instructions" (or similar sections)

- The following actions constitute misconduct. If you engage in misconduct, you will be disqualified from taking the examination and your exam results will be invalidated.
 - (a) Making false statements or falsifying application documents, examination materials, or official declarations.
 - (b) Cheating or assisting others in cheating.
 - (c) Failing to follow the instructions of proctors or university staff.
 - (d) Engaging in any behavior that risks compromising the fairness of the examination.
- If you possess or use items that are not permitted during the examination, or if such prohibited items are discovered on your person during the exam, this may be deemed as misconduct.
- If any doubts or suspicions arise regarding your submitted documents or your conduct during the examination, the university may conduct additional verifications as necessary. Furthermore, in cases of malicious or severe misconduct, the university may take legal action, which may include reporting the incident to relevant authorities or filing a report with the police.
